Andy Haines was Director (formerly Dean) of the LSHTM from 2001- October 2010, having been trained in family practice and epidemiology. His interest in climate change and health developed in the 1990's and he was a member of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change for the 2nd, 3rd and 5th assessment exercises.

He chaired the Rockefeller Foundation /Lancet Commission on Planetary Health (2014-2015) and he is currently co-chairing the Lancet Pathfinder Commission on health in the net zero economy and a member of the US National Academy of Medicine Climate Change and Health Grand Challenge steering group.

He was awarded the Tyler Prize for Environmental Achievement in 2022.
