Judith Rodin is a pioneer, innovator, and global thought-leader, having led and transformed two institutions: The Rockefeller Foundation and the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Rodin has served as a member of the board for leading corporations and nonprofits, and currently co-chairs The National Academy of Medicine's Grand Challenge on Climate Change, Human Health and Equity.

She has authored more than 200 academic articles and chapters, and has written or co-written 15 books, including *The Power of Impact Investing: Putting Markets to Work for Profit and Global Good* and *The Resilience Dividend: Being Strong in a World Where Things Go Wrong*. Dr. Rodin's latest book is entitled *Making Money Moral: How a New Wave of Visionaries is Linking Purpose and Profit*.
